

Pest Control Notice

Wanda Lane, Tobin Drive & Ronald Court Infrastructure Upgrades & Rehabilitation

Dear Residents:

As you are aware, Halifax Water and Halifax Regional Municipality are upgrading infrastructure on **Wanda Lane, Tobin Drive and Ronald Court.**

It has been brought to our attention that the work is being associated with an increase in rodent activity in the area. Halifax Water and HRM, through our general contractor, has engaged a pest control company, Rentokil, to deploy bait stations along the upper reach of Ellenvale Run. This is the section of Ellenvale Run that runs behind Christopher Avenue from Civic 14 to Civic 3 Tobin Drive.

What to Expect

The pest control company will be deploying bait stations on Wednesday, July 17, 2019. To aid in this deployment pest control company employees will need to access your property in order to place bait stations at the rear of your property. The stations are a lockable, covered, black box designed not to be accessible to anything other than rodents. The stations will be checked regularly and will be deployed throughout the duration of the project. If you do not want to have a bait station on your property, please contact Tom Hurshman with Rentokil.
