

Community Notice 4

Wanda Lane, Tobin Drive & Ronald Court Infrastructure Upgrades & Rehabilitation

August 7, 2019

Halifax Water and the Halifax Regional Municipality are upgrading infrastructure on **Wanda Lane, Tobin Drive** and **Ronald Court**. Halifax Water's work includes the replacement of the water and wastewater system in various areas, the addition of a deep stormwater system on Wanda Lane, and channel improvements in Ellenvale Run. The municipality is undertaking various street improvements including curb, gutter and sidewalk work, as well as the replacement of the bridge on Tobin Drive.

Project Update - Weeks of August 12 & August 19

Wanda Lane

- Excavate/break/install/ backfill sanitary and storm mains
- Sanitary, storm and water services install
- Continue asphalt removal up Wanda
- Continue full depth gravel removal and replacement with type 2 gravel
- Continue to install water main

Tobin Drive

- Storm/sanitary/water installation
- Sanitary lateral replacement
- Partial asphalt removal

Ellenvale Run

- By-Pass pumping
- Removal of brook infill/ excavation
- Rock mitigation measures
- Rock removal
- Prep bedding for concrete liner
- Liner installation and backfill
- Placement of stone/riffles in liner
- Prep for bridge abutments

Project Timeline

Week of June 3, 2019

Survey work, some environmental controls, brush clearing/tree cutting, property investigations/videos, begin temporary water installation.

Early-July 2019

Closure of through traffic on Tobin Drive, removal of existing bridge on Tobin Drive and begin Ellenvale Run Channel Rehabilitation work.

Late-October/Early November 2019

Completion of paving and landscaping.

Late-June 2019

Completion of temporary water installation.

Begin excavation and installation of new mains beginning at the Belle Vista Drive end of Wanda Lane.

Late-September/Early October 2019

Completion of Ellenvale Run Channel Rehabilitation work.

Safety Reminder

The work going on along Ellenvale Run and on Wanda Lane, Tobin Drive, and Ronald Court is certainly interesting to watch, but we ask that all residents and onlookers view the work being completed from a safe distance. Safety barricades and fences have been installed for the safety of the public and the workers completing this work. Please stay well outside of these barriers and fences at all times. Even when machinery has stopped moving during a break in work or on evenings and weekends, the fenced off areas are to be entered only by authorized personnel wearing the required safety equipment.

Please follow any instructions given by the contractor, Dexter Construction, especially when inside the active work area. These instructions are for your safety and the safety of the workers in the area. We appreciate your understanding of this important safety reminder.
