Re: Road Closures for Infrastructure Enhancements

As part of water, wastewater and stormwater upgrades, as well as enhancements to area curb, gutter and sidewalk, Dexter Construction, on behalf of Halifax Water and Halifax Municipality, will require rolling/sectioned road closures on Wanda Lane, Tobin Drive and, Ronald Court.

Wanda Lane will require a sectioned/rolling road closure beginning on or about Tuesday, July 2nd. The road closure will begin at the Bella Vista end and progress up Wanda Lane in sections approximately 30 meters in length. The closure will be in affect until mid/late October. Driveways in the work zone will be closed and no through traffic will be available. The sidewalk will remain open.

Tobin Drive will require a road closure beginning on or about Tuesday, July 2nd between Wanda Lane and Christopher Avenue. The closure will be in affect until late September. During the closure, no pedestrian or vehicle through traffic will be available and there will be no access to Wanda Lane.

A road closure will also be required from Christopher Avenue to the end of the cul-de-sac. This closure will begin on or about Wednesday, July 24th and end mid August. The road closure will be moving up the street as the pipe work progresses. During the closure, no vehicle through traffic will be available.

Accommodations will be made for emergency vehicle access on all noted road closures.

Traffic control barricades will be setup at either end of the road closures. On site personnel will also maintain communication with residents to help minimize disruption. Motorists are asked to use alternate routes. Motorists are also reminded that speed fines double in work zones. Sidewalks, where existing, will remain open for pedestrians.

Please note, the closure dates provided above are estimates and dependant on a number of factors, including weather.
