Dexter Construction, on behalf of Halifax Water and Halifax Regional Municipality, will be upgrading infrastructure on Federal Avenue, Romans Avenue and McAlpine Avenue.

Halifax Water's work will include the installation of new water main and storm sewer. The municipality will be undertaking various street improvements, including curb, gutter and new pavement work. See the map on the back of this notice for more project details.

Construction During COVID-19

From time to time, you will see workers within 2 metres of each other while they work to maintain the critical water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure serving your home. As an essential service, **contractors are exempt from the current 2-metre social/physical distancing rules.** However, when possible, **crews will strive to maintain physical distancing measures.**

We ask that residents please ensure they give construction crews at least 2 metres of distancing as well.

Keeping You In-The-Know

We are working hard to ensure we keep the residents impacted by this work up-to-date on this project.

Due to the current COVID-19 situation, door to door delivery of construction information notices by Halifax Water or contractor staff is not possible. **To make staying in-the-know as easy as possible, we have set up an email list for residents to sign up to receive future updates.** Project updates typically come every two weeks. Project Work: April 20 - May 1, 2020

During these two weeks, machinery and other equipment will arrive on-site. The contractor will set up and test a temporary water system (some temporary water prep work may begin the week of April 13.) Asphalt will be cut in multiple areas; a layer of asphalt will be removed from sections of Federal Avenue. Rock breaking will take place, and new storm sewer main sections will be installed on Federal Avenue, McAlpine Avenue, and the walkway easement near McAlpine Avenue. Traffic control will be on-site throughout the project.

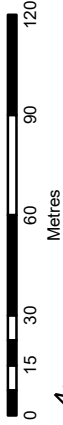
