Atlantic Road Construction & Paving (ARCP) Limited, on behalf of Halifax Water will be replacing seven culverts on Coronet Avenue.

Each culvert replacement is expected to take 3-5 days to complete, depending on weather and installation complexity. During the replacement of each culvert, a section of Coronet Avenue will be closed to all vehicles. As culvert replacements require excavation work where the driveway meets Coronet Avenue, customers will not have driveway access during the replacement of the culvert in front of their property.

Some road closure sections will be larger than others, and will last longer than others. If two or more culverts are close enough, the section of closed road may cover both/all of them. That closure will be in place during the replacement of all culverts in that section, meaning that section will be closed for a longer period of time.

The contractor, ARCP, will communicate directly with customers before beginning the culvert replacement that impacts access to their property.

This work will begin the week of August 10, with crews setting up traffic control, delivering equipment and materials, etc., followed by the first culvert replacement, as shown on the project map.

To keep excess water out of the culverts during replacements, a pump will be installed at the top of the hill to divert stormwater from the work area through pipes/hoses. This pump will run during the day, and be turned off at night.

## Construction & Contractor Work During COVID-19

Effective June 18<sup>th</sup>, Public Health Authorities allow for groups of up to 10 people to be within 2 metres of each other, and from time to time, you will see workers within 2 metres of each other while they work to maintain the critical water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure serving your home. Halifax Water is still mindful of the recommendations to maintain a 2 metre distance between employees and contractors, and every effort will be made to achieve this. However, some tasks cannot be completed safely otherwise. As an essential service, in these instances, Halifax Water and its contractors have been exempt from the 2 metre social/physical distancing rules. Halifax Water and its contractors will use additional PPE to protect themselves when undertaking these activities.

We ask that residents please ensure they give construction crews at least 2 metres of distancing as well.
