

Community Notice 8

Federal Avenue, Romans Avenue & McAlpine Avenue Sewer Separation Project

August 19, 2020

Dexter Construction, on behalf of Halifax Water and Halifax Regional Municipality, will be upgrading infrastructure on Federal Avenue, Romans Avenue and McAlpine Avenue.

Halifax Water's work will include the installation of new water main and storm sewer. The municipality will be undertaking various street improvements, including curb, gutter and new pavement work. See the map on the back of this notice for more project details.

Project Work: August 21 - September 4, 2020

Romans Avenue

- Continued rock breaking and installation of stormwater main to complete installation at the intersection of Romans Avenue & Bayers Road.
- Backfill trench and open sections.
- Install catchbasin leads.

Federal Avenue

- Install new water main.
- Start restoration of curb and sidewalk.
- Prep/grade road for paving.
- Raise manhole covers for paving.
- Pave base layer of asphalt.

McAlpine Avenue

- Complete walkway restoration work.
- Restoration work.

Due unexpected quantities of hard bedrock, the expected end date of the work on this project is mid-October, 2020.

Construction & Contractor Work During COVID-19

Effective June 18th, Public Health Authorities allow for groups of up to 10 people to be within 2 metres of each other, and from time to time, you will see workers within 2 metres of each other while they work to maintain the critical water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure serving your home. Halifax Water is still mindful of the recommendations to maintain a 2 metre distance between employees and contractors, and every effort will be made to achieve this. However, some tasks cannot be completed safely otherwise. As an essential service, in these instances, Halifax Water and its contractors have been exempt from the 2 metre social/physical distancing rules. Halifax Water and its contractors will use additional PPE to protect themselves when undertaking these activities.

We ask that residents please ensure they give construction crews at least 2 metres of distancing as well.
