Halifax Water is upgrading the Russell Lake Wastewater Pump Station (PS) and the wastewater pipe that runs near much of this trail. Work on the pump station and wastewater pipe will begin on or about Monday, April 26.

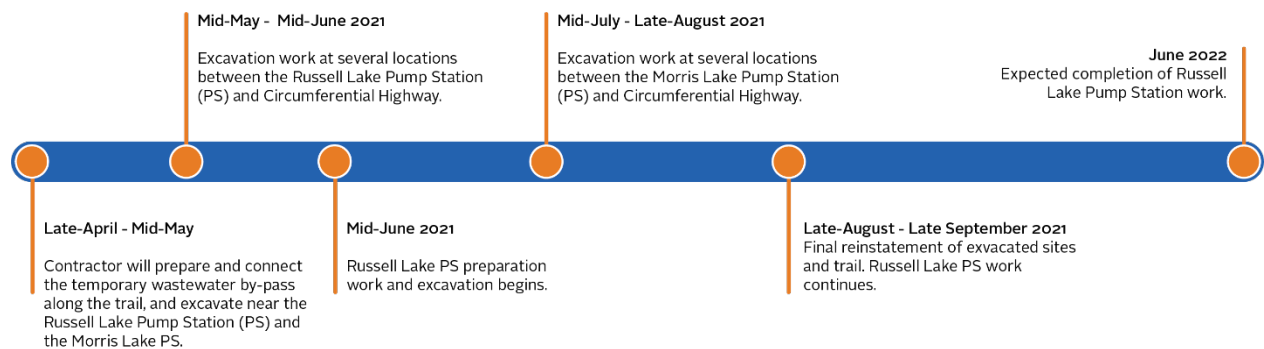
Wastewater pipe work is scheduled for completion at the end of September. Pump station work is scheduled for completion in June 2022.

During construction, it is expected the trail will remain open at all times, or pedestrian detours will be in place to ensure safe passage around the construction activities.

Two-Week Timeline: April 26 – May 7

Crews on-site near the Morris Lake Pump Station (PS); set up temporary wastewater pipe along the trail from Morris Lake PS to Russell Lake PS; excavation near the Russell Lake PS.
