## NOTICE OF PAPER HEARING

**HALIFAX REGIONAL WATER COMMISSION** applied to the Board on October 13, 2021 for approval of the transfer of certain stormwater assets from the Halifax Regional Municipality; the application of Halifax Water's current rates, charges, and regulations governing Halifax Water's delivery of stormwater services, and charging Halifax Regional Municipality the Right of Way Charge for the additional kilometers of road in the new service areas.

The new service areas include certain areas in Boutilier's Point, Head of St. Margaret's Bay, Hubley, Ingramport, Lewis Lake, Upper Tantallon, East Preston, Lake Echo, Lawrencetown, and Mineville.

The Board will consider this matter in a paper hearing process.
