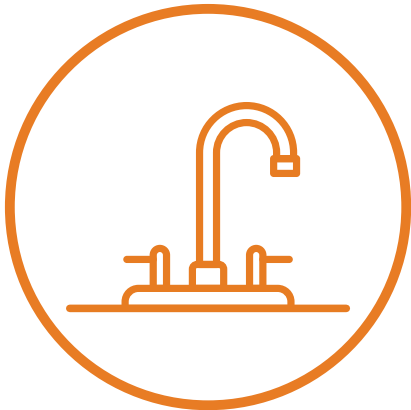


# Using Less Water at School

## Water Saving Tips:



**Avoid letting the water run while you wash your hands.**

- Turn the tap on and apply soap.
- Then turn the tap off and lather soap.
- Turn the tap back on to rinse hands.



**Only flush toilet paper, pee, and poo.**

**Only flush when necessary.**

**Garbage, tissues, and other waste belongs in the garbage bin.**



**If showering at school is a necessity, take short showers and turn on the water only to get wet. Then lather your products and turn water back on to rinse off.**

**5-minute shower = ~50 L  
25-minute shower = ~250 L**
